

#### **Dear Pennsylvania Grower**

This special edition of the Pennsylvania Vegetable Growers News, the monthly newsletter of the Pennsylvania Vegetable Growers Association, has been prepared as a source book of information for you, the Pennsylvania grower. We have listed various vendors of equipment, supplies and services who deal with Pennsylvania growers. Keep this booklet handy to refer to throughout the year.

We also ask you to consider joining the Pennsylvania Vegetable Growers Association. If you are a vegetable, potato or berry grower, you should belong to the organization that represents your industry. Founded in 1926, PVGA has been serving growers like you for 90 years. Your membership will strengthen the Association's position as the official voice of the vegetable, potato and berry industries and will also provide numerous benefits to you.

For example, each year the Association co-sponsors the Mid-Atlantic Fruit and Vegetable Convention in Hershey. This meeting is one of the most respected vegetable meetings on the East Coast and offers three days of concurrent sessions on processing vegetables, fresh market vegetables, potatoes, small fruits, bedding plants, direct marketing, organic vegetables, cut flowers and other specialty crops. As a member of the Association, you help make this convention possible and you receive reduced registration fees. PVGA also sponsors field days at Penn State's research plots, and regional grower meetings.

As a member, you will receive monthly subscriptions to this newsletter, the **Pennsylvania Vegetable Grower News,** to keep you informed on what is happening in the vegetable, potato and berry industries. PVGA members also receive free subscriptions to the **American Vegetable Grower** and the **Vegetable Growers News.** 

Last year, the Association gave over \$81 per member of the Association or a total of \$81,000 to Penn State University researchers to sponsor practical vegetable and berry research. This was made possible through the Association's food booths at the Pennsylvania Farm Show and Ag Progress Days. These food booths also help to promote the vegetable and berry products you produce.

PVGA represents the interests of the vegetable, potato and berry industries on both state and federal issues. The Association contacts legislators regularly on issues that affect our growers. Special attention is given to food safety, state budget appropriations, labor, deer crop damage, irrigation (water use), and pesticides as they relate to horticultural growers.

The Association is also a member of the State Council of Farm Organizations, the United Fresh Produce Association and the Penn State Agricultural Council, again with the purpose of representing the vegetable, potato and berry industries in the public arena and to Penn State University researchers and administrators.

The bottom line is this. A \$50 membership in the Pennsylvania Vegetable Growers Association is worth every penny. For each member, about \$81 is given to research, about \$22 is spent to publish the **Pennsylvania Vegetable Growers News**, and up to \$85 per person can be saved on three-day registration fees for the Mid-Atlantic Fruit and Vegetable. That adds up to \$188 or over triple the return on your dues investment.
